



RED CROSS REFUND POLICY

If you are unable to attend a first aid course, to be eligible for a refund you must notify the Continuing Education office 48 hours prior to the first class.

SPECIAL NOTICE

All Red Cross First Aid courses offered through Langley Continuing Education now include instruction, practice, and certification in the use of an Automated External Defibrillator to restart a cardiac arrest victim's heart, which greatly increases the person's chance of survival. Courses will also include all the 'brand new CPR techniques'.

Emergency First Aid With CPR C

1-8 hr or 2-4 hr sessions FA08
\$85 (incl manual)

This course is by far the most popular of the first aid courses. It covers basic first aid and CPR for infants, children and adults, including the use of an Automated External Defibrillator. This course should be considered a 'must take' for parents, grandparents, noon-hour supervisors, coaches, etc. You will learn the skills necessary to deal with a variety of life-threatening emergencies, including bleeding, choking, heart attack and shock. No previous training necessary. Upon successful completion, students will receive a nationally recognized, three-year Red Cross First Aid/CPR C and AED certificate.

Standard First Aid With CPR C

2 sessions FA09
\$126 (incl manual)

This two-day course teaches a wide variety of first aid skills for people in all walks of life. You will learn how to deal with

common injuries and illnesses, as well as life-threatening emergencies. The CPR component covers adult, child and infant skills, including the use of an automated defibrillator. Management of a choking victim, and how to recognize and care for someone having a heart attack or stroke will also be taught. This course is commonly required by persons entering a Nursing, Residential Care Aid, medical/hospital, or life guarding training program. Upon successful completion, students will receive a nationally recognized three-year Red Cross Standard First Aid/CPR C and AED certificate.

Emergency Childcare First Aid With CPR B

1 session FA05
\$85 (incl manual)

This new course is designed for childcare workers, and includes CPR and obstructed airway management for infants, children and youth, as well as basic first aid for common injuries such as bleeding, burns, fractures, etc. Child safety measures are also discussed. This course meets the newly revised Provincial Child Care Facilities Licensing Board requirements for childcare workers, and includes certification in Automated External Defibrillation. Upon successful completion, students will receive a nationally recognized three-year Red Cross Emergency First Aid/CPR B and AED certificate.

CPR C

This course is designed for professional rescuers, or those entering the health care field. It includes CPR, advanced airway management skills for all ages, two-rescuer CPR, and the use of an Automated External Defibrillator. A three-year Red Cross CPR C and AED certificate will be issued.
