

Oil Painting Course

Supply List

Paint:

Buy the cheaper artists quality, not student quality.

Medium or large size tubes of:

2 reds (one warm , one cool)

2 blues (one warm , one cool)

2 yellows (one warm , one cool)

Flake or Titanium white

Raw sienna, Burnt Sienna

Raw Umber, Burnt Umber

Black

Note: You may purchase Black but it is also recommended to mix black instead.

Almost any combination of two deep, dark colors – one warm, the other cool:

Ultramarine and burnt umber

Prussian blue and burnt sienna

Thalo green and alizarin crimson.

Linseed Oil

Odourless Turpentine (orange citrus thinner is toxic free)

(Note: Solvents sold in hardware stores are not artist's quality and can cause yellowing.)

Rags and container to keep them in

Brushes: At least three sizes of oil painting brushes (natural or synthetic)

Palette knives: 2 sizes

Palette: any type

2 Hardboard: pre-gessoed/primed - min. 16" x 20"

2 Canvas: pre-gessoed/primed - min. 16" x 20"

Appropriate Clothing
