Persons of *all* ages are now required to have a boating license to operate a motorized vessel of *any* size.

This short, information-packed course is intended for persons with previous boating experience, who now require a Boating License. Taught by federally accredited, and Canada Coast Guard approved Instructors, the course will prepare you for writing the PCOC written exam, which is given during the final 30 minutes of the course. Students who pass the short written exam will receive a ‘lifetime’ Pleasure Craft Operator Certificate Card. The course will cover topics which may appear on the exam, including safety and general boating regulations, navigational aids, emergency procedures, use of flares, right of way, fueling procedures, and much more.
